

# Level Maintenance



**Purpose:** Establishes grade levels and defines promotion of students

Important: Input oldest Grade Level first

In this example, the 9th grade students upon promotion are removed from the committee.

### Level Maintenance Field Definition

**Field Level:** defines the levels/grades to be used in creating the religious ed classes. When entering this field keep it simple. This field is the same field that you will enter into the **Committee Position** when adding your Students to the Committees.

Description: A more detailed description of the class

**Next Description:** Defines the next level your students will be promoted to on year completion.

**Religious Education Email:** can be used to define an email that is to be used that is different than the Religious Ed email defined in the Administrative Tab.

Student Fee: Fee for the class. This value is not collected by the system

Sacrament Name: Specify if the class ends with the conferring of a Sacrament

Create Religious Education Committees for Aides, Student and Teachers



- 1. Click on Committees via the top navigation bar and select Committee Maintenance
- 2. At the top of the screen, click New Committee
- 3. A pop up will appear
  - Enter in the name of the committee (Recommended choices might be Religious Education Aides, RE Aides or Faith Formation Aides)
  - Enter in a description. You may use the committee name in this field
  - The drop down below the description is used to signify that this Committee will be used in Ministry Scheduling only. This will default to no. Do not change the value
- 4. Press Save and the Committee is added and will appear in the Committee List and in the Committee drop-down in Member Maintenance. Repeat this process for creating a committee for students and teachers. Now you are ready to add teacher aides, students and teachers to the committee.

### **Church Maintenance**

Once the 3 committees have been added for Religious Education, you need to tag them within the Church Maintenance Screen. The order is : Teacher, Aides, Students



### Purpose of the Church Maintenance Religious Education fields

- 1. Religious Education email: Used when emailing from Class Maintenance
- 2. Religious Education Teachers: Class setup
- 3. Religious Education Aides: Class setup
- 4. Religious Education Students: Class setup

**Future purpose:** Religious Education Online Registration will use the Religious Education Email to cc communication to the registering family


### Room Setup

**Purpose:** Setting up all the rooms where your religious education classes will be meeting. If you have a home study program you can set-up classes for that as well. Inputting rooms are optional when setting up classes.

**To Add a Room:** Click New Room and fill in the pop up box


**up?:** *No.* This is an optional step, but does help with overall program organization if there are multiple classrooms per grade

How to create a new Class: Navigate to Religious Education/Class Maintenance


New Class: You have not added any classes to RE module or need to add another class




# Adding a new Class

Highlighting a couple fields:

- (Level) Click on the drop-down and choose a Level. The Level which is taken directly from the description column that you entered in Level Maintenance.
- 2. **(Room)** Click on the drop-down and choose the room where the class will meet.
- (Teachers) choose the teachers from the drop-down menu. This list is taken directly from the Religious Ed Teacher committee listing you created under Committees. Teachers can be assigned to multiple classes.
- 4. Completed Flag When you have completed all your classes at the end of the year and you Promote your students this box will automatically be checked and all the students who are currently in your RE Student Committee will be moved to the next level based on your Level Maintenance setup. Note: Promoting your students does not create new classes.
- Registration dates: are not being used in the Online Registration module




